Bulleit Bourbon Distillery & Kentucky Derby Museum Tours (6/14/17) The **TWO** things Kentucky is known for: Horse racing and Bourbon! Your adventure begins with a guided tour of **Bulleit Distillery**, which opened in 1987. **The next stop** is the world famous **Kentucky Derby Museum** at Churchill Downs, for a guided tour, a track side visit, and lunch. Each participant takes home a swag bag of items when they return. Tickets of **\$39 each** are required, and include both tours.

Dinner Cruise on the Belle of Louisville (6/14/17)

This will be a fun-filled evening of dinner, paddelwheeling, laughter and friendship among MVPA members! Tickets for the dinner cruise are limited, so register and purchase your tickets for what, to some, will be the highlight of the convention! The General George S. Patton Museum of Leadership (6/15/17) Located at Fort Knox, KY, the tour will include visiting the museum, the LST Building, and possibly seeing soldiers in training. Visitors will enjoy lunch at the Fort Knox Military Dining Facility, and then take a windshield tour of Fort Knox. *A US Government issued photo ID is required. Foreign Nationals will need their passport, Visa or Border Crossing Card.* Advance tickets of **\$35 each** are required.

Falls of the Ohio State Park and Frasier Museum Tours (6/16/17) - Begin your day with a trip across the Ohio River to the **Falls of the Ohio State Park**, two unbelievable natural phenomenon, and the largest exposed Devonian fossil bed in the world! Lunch is not provided, but guests will have ample time to dine at a local eatery of their choice. Then its on to the **Frazier History Museum**, on historic West Main Street, with its signature exhibits of weaponry, and a WWI display, including a walk through frontline trench. Advance tickets of **\$39 each** are required and includes both tours.



The 14th Armor Re-Creation Unit will have their WWII Field Encampment set up behind the KY Expo Center, which includes three M-5 light tanks. as well as all the support equipment necessary for maintenance in the field.
